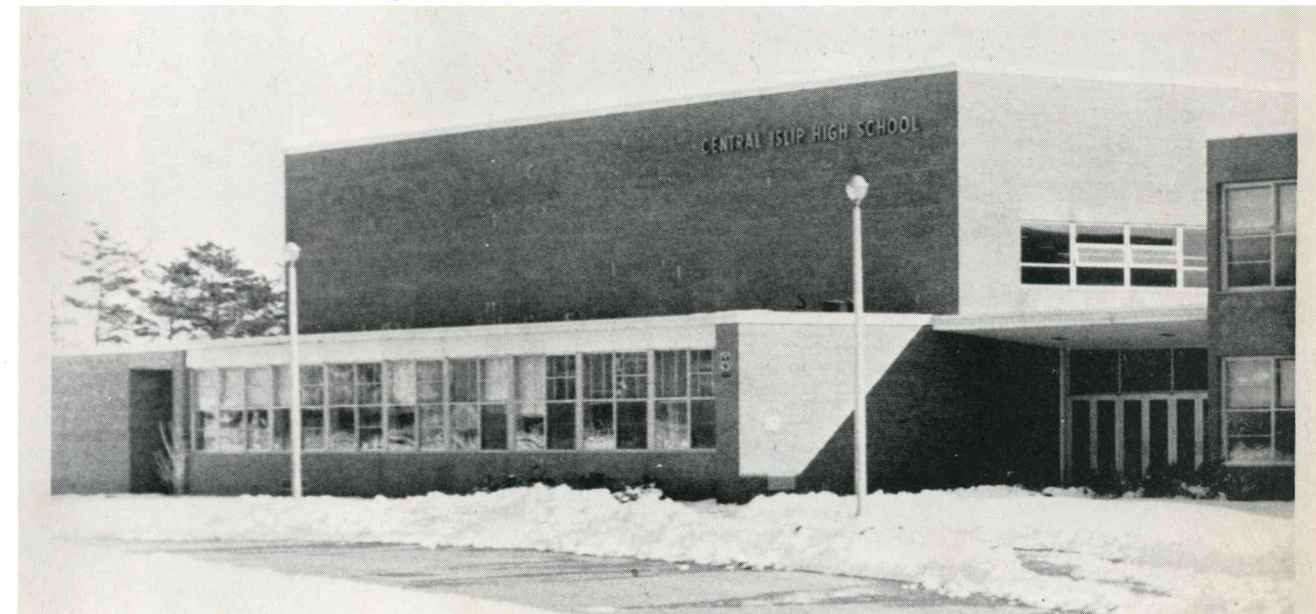

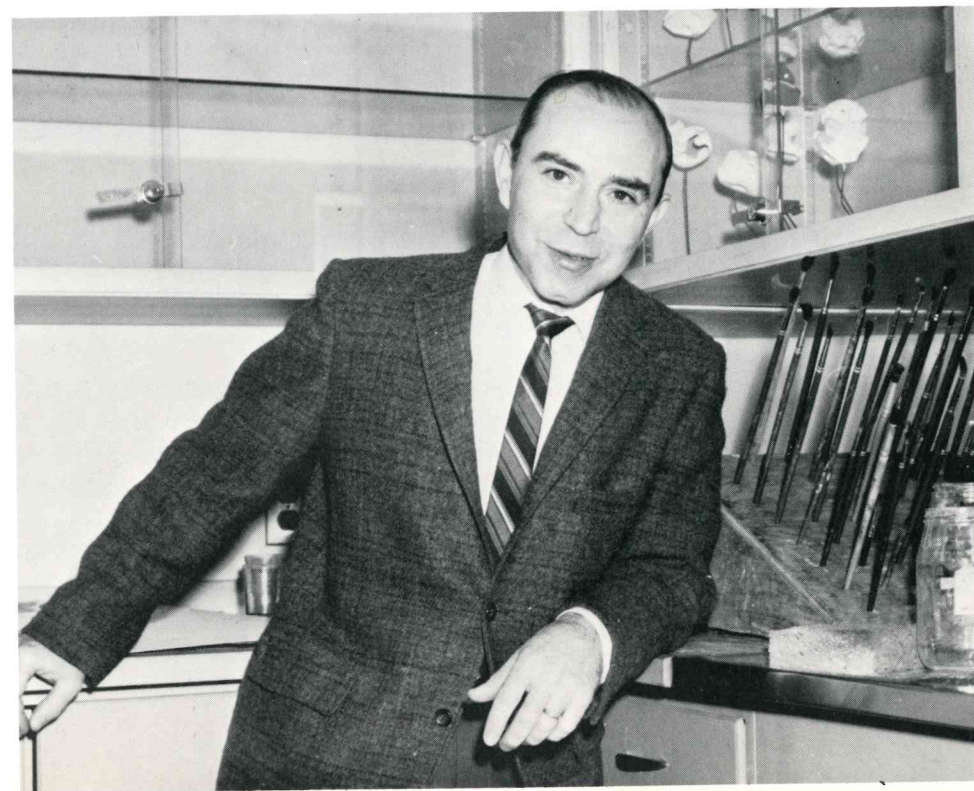

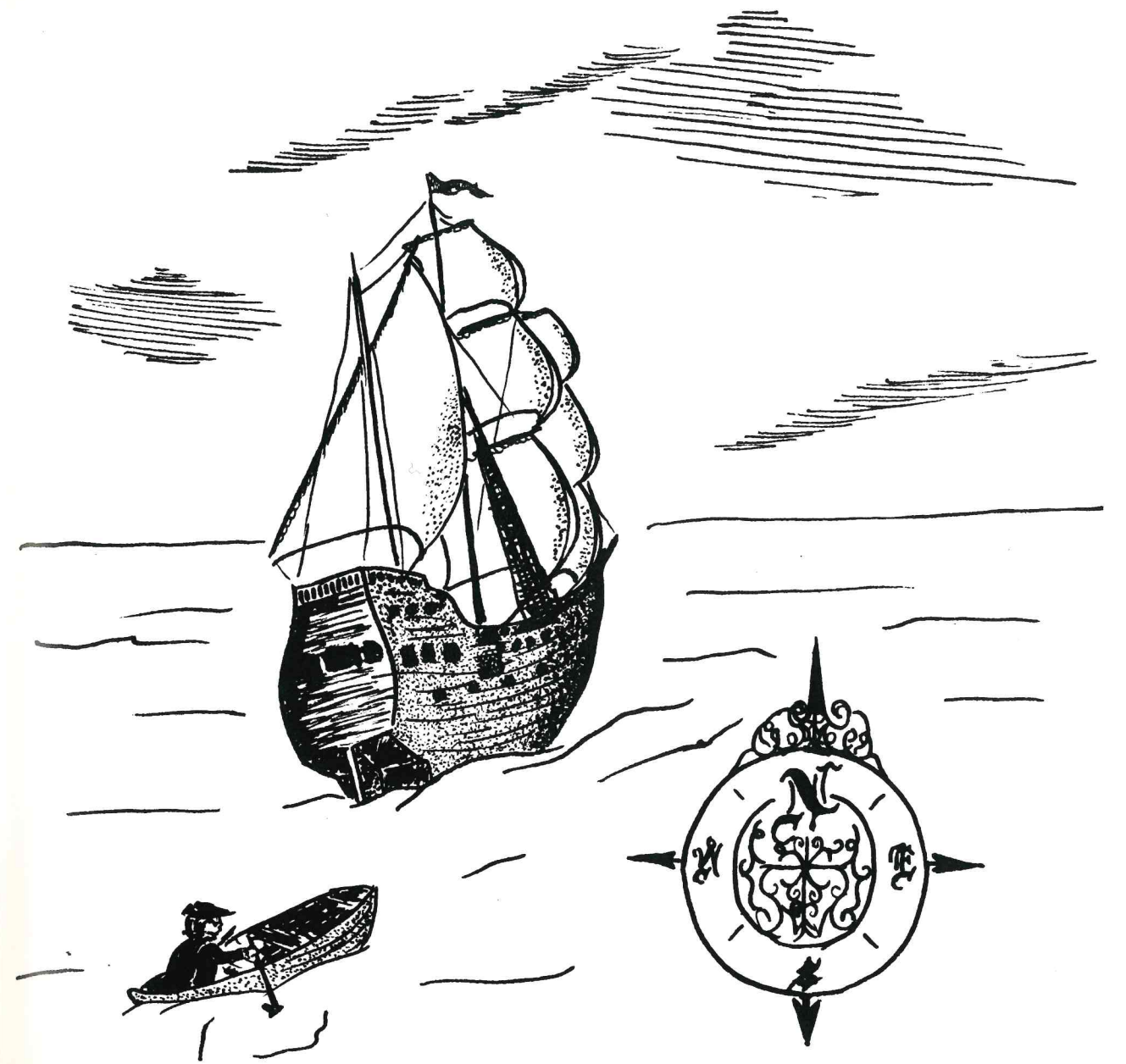
OUR HIGH SCHOOL PRINCIPAL
